2 On page 11, delete lines 9 through 26 and insert:

"Section 5. The plan adopted by this Act will lose any effectiveness whatsoever if any court so empowered reverses, vacates, or stays the decision of the United States District Court, Middle District of Louisiana issued on June 6, 2022, in case number 3:22-cv-002211, to preliminarily enjoin the state from conducting congressional elections occurring while that case is pending under the map enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana in Act 5 of the 2022 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, or if the decision is otherwise enjoined, made inoperable, or ineffective. In any such case, Act 5 of the 2022 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature will become again effective.

Section 6. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
