Existing law (Ch.C. Art. 801 et seq.) provides for delinquency proceedings.

Existing law (Ch.C. Art. 905) provides that every six months, any institution, agency, or person to which a child is assigned shall report the child's whereabouts and condition to the court and the child's counsel.

<u>Prior law</u> required that the reports be provided not less than 72 hours prior to any in-court review hearing.

 $\underline{\text{New law}}$ changes $\underline{\text{existing law}}$ to require that the report shall also be provided to the district attorney.

<u>New law</u> changes <u>prior law</u> to require that the reports be provided not less than one week prior to any in-court review hearing.

Effective August 1, 2022.
