Creates a joint subcommittee to be comprised of eight total members with two members each appointed from the House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works, the House Committee on Commerce, the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works, and the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs to examine and study port infrastructure strategies. Requires the subcommittee submit its findings to the legislature via a report prior to the convening of the 2023 R.S.
