<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the La. State Racing Commission (commission) to issue licenses in accordance with <u>existing law</u> and applicable rules and regulations adopted by the commission. Authorizes the commission to revoke a license to cause the license holder to become ineligible to participate in racing.

New law retains existing law.

<u>Prior law</u> provided for a license issued by the commission to remain active for a period of not more than one year.

<u>New law</u> deletes the time period in <u>prior law</u> and instead extends the license period <u>from</u> not more than one year to not more than three years.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes owners, trainers, jockeys, jockey agents, exercise persons, and veterinarians to renew the annual license fee for up to a three-year period which expires on June 30<sup>th</sup> of the third year. <u>Existing law</u> applies to the registration of colors.

<u>New law</u> retains and extends <u>existing law</u> to the renewals of annual license fees for partnership licenses.

Effective June 30, 2022.
