<u>New law</u> requires primary care providers who perform early and periodic screening, diagnostic, and treatment preventive visits in accordance with American Academy of Pediatrics guidelines to promote age-appropriate screenings including, unless otherwise medically indicated, a standardized screening for autism spectrum disorder at any routine well child visit.

<u>New law</u> stipulates that no primary care provider shall be liable for any civil damages or be subject to any disciplinary action by his licensing board as a result of any act or omission in connection with delivering or not delivering any service provided for in <u>new law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2022.
