Existing law allows the secretary of state to collect \$25 for transferring a reserved corporate name.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and expands the fee to include transferring a reserved limited liability company name and terminating a reserved corporate name or limited liability company name.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the secretary of state to collect certain fees relative to various filings, recordings, registrations, renewals, and terminations.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and authorizes the secretary of state to collect two new fees as follows:

- (1) Filing an initial structured settlement purchase company registration \$600.
- (2) Renewing a structured settlement purchase company registration \$250.

Effective August 1, 2022.
