SCHOOLS: Requires display of the national motto, "In God We Trust", in every public elementary, secondary, and postsecondary education classroom

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:262(A)(2) and (B) and to enact R.S. 17:262(C) and 3351(O)

4	display of the national motto in each classroom; to provide relative to the use of
5	public funds for this purpose; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:262(A)(2) and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
8	17:262(C) and 3351(O) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

13	on patriotic customs required by this Section shall include instruction on the national
4	motto, "In God We Trust", and each public school governing authority shall display

16	jurisdiction. The nature of the display shall be determined by each governing
17	authority, with a minimum requirement of a paper sign.
18	B. This Section does not require a public school governing authority to spend
19	its funds to purchase national motto displays. A governing authority may spend its
20	funds or donated funds to purchase the displays and may accept donated displays.

9	display the national motto, "In God We Trust", in each classroom on the institution's

13	management board or a public postsecondary education institution to spend its funds
14	to purchase such displays. An institution or management board may spend its funds
15	or donated funds to purchase such displays and may accept donated displays.

**Abstract:** Requires the display of the national motto in each classroom in each public school and in each public postsecondary education institution.

Present law requires each public school governing authority to display the national motto, "In God We Trust", in each building it uses and in each school under its jurisdiction.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes this requirement <u>from</u> in each building and each school <u>to</u> in each classroom in each school.

<u>Present law</u> specifies that the nature of the display shall be determined by each governing authority with a minimum requirement of a paper sign. Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law additionally requires display of the national motto in every classroom on public postsecondary education institution campuses.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>proposed law</u> does not require spending public funds to purchase displays.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words underscored are additions.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes governing authorities, management boards, and institutions to accept donated displays and to spend their funds or donated funds to purchase displays.
