LOCAL GOVT/ORDINANCES: Requires local governments that issue permits for parades to require the parade organization to provide for cleanup of litter

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 33:3744, relative to litter abatement in parishes and municipalities; to require
3	parish and municipal governing authorities to require organizations holding parades
4	to provide for litter abatement; to provide relative to local ordinances governing such
5	abatement; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 33:3744 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	<u>§3744.</u> Parade permits; litter abatement
9	A. Any parish or municipality that authorizes an organization to use public
10	rights-of-way for the purpose of holding a parade shall require each such
11	organization to:
12	(1) Provide for removal of litter from all used rights-of-way within twenty-
13	four hours after completion of the parade and appropriate disposal of such litter.
14	(2) Pay a monetary deposit as surety for the timely removal and appropriate
15	disposal of litter.
16	B. Any parish or municipality that authorizes use of public rights-of-way for
17	parades shall adopt an ordinance to implement the requirements of this Section.
18	Each such ordinance shall:
19	(1) Specify appropriate methods for litter removal and disposal.

1	(2) Establish a process by which the parish or municipality determines
2	whether the organization has adequately removed and appropriately disposed of
3	litter.
4	(3) Establish the amount or a method for determining the amount of the
5	deposit that an organization is required to pay.
6	(4) Establish consequences for failure to comply with requirements for litter
7	removal and disposal, including forfeit of some or all of the deposit.

Abstract: Requires parishes and municipalities to require organizations holding parades to provide for litter abatement.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the governing authority of any parish or municipality that authorizes an organization to use public rights-of-way for the purpose of holding a parade to require that each such organization provide for removal of litter from all used rights-of-way within 24 hours after completion of the parade and pay a deposit as surety for removal and disposal of litter.

Further requires each governing authority that authorizes organizations to hold parades to adopt an ordinance to implement <u>proposed law</u>, which ordinance shall:

- (1) Specify appropriate methods of litter abatement and disposal.
- (2) Specify a process by which the parish or municipality determines whether the organization has adequately removed and appropriately disposed of litter.
- (3) Establish the amount or a method for determining the amount of the deposit.
- (4) Establish consequences for failure to comply with requirements for litter removal and disposal.
