#### Abstract

AN ACT To amend and reenact R.S. 15:572.1(E), relative to the Board of Pardons; to provide relative to the quorum of the Board of Pardons; to provide for voting requirements; and to provide for related matters.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 15:572.1(E) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §572.1. Board of Pardons; membership; domicile; session; quorum
E. Four of the five members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and all actions of the board shall require the favorable vote of at least four members of the board unless only four members are present. When only four members are present, all actions of the board shall require the favorable vote of at least three members.

[^0]Present law (R.S. 15:572.1) creates the Board of Pardons and provides for its membership.
Present law (R.S. 15:572.1(E)) provides that four members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and all actions of the board shall require the favorable vote of at least four members of the board.

Proposed law amends present law to provide that four of five members of the board shall constitute a quorum unless only four members are present. Further provides that when only four members are present, a favorable vote of at least three members is required for the board to take action.
