Abstract: Provides for the reversal, stay, and appeal of a decision by the commissioner of alcohol and tobacco control.

Present law provides that decisions of the commissioner in withholding, suspending or revoking permits are final and binding unless appealed.

Proposed law retains present law and adds additional remedies including stay or reversal by the courts.

Present law provides that an aggrieved party may file a petition for appeal within 10 days of the decision.

Proposed law changes the amount of days to file a petition for appeal from 10 to 30.
