

1 Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election,
2 there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
3 to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
4 follows:

5 Do you support an amendment to prohibit the use of funds, goods, or services
6 from a foreign government or a nongovernmental source for the conduct of
7 elections and election functions and duties unless the use is authorized by law
8 or by the secretary of state in accordance with policies established in

Abstract: Prohibits the use of funds and resources from a foreign government or a nongovernmental source for the conduct of elections and for the functions and duties related to the administration and conduct of elections as provided in the election code except as specifically authorized by law or by the secretary of state in accordance with policies established in accordance with law.

Present constitution provides that the legislature shall adopt an election code providing for the permanent registration of voters and for the conduct of all elections.

Proposed constitutional amendment prohibits except as otherwise specifically provided by law, funds, goods, or services donated by a foreign government or a nongovernmental source from being used for any function or duty established in the election code or to conduct an election unless the use is authorized by the secretary of state in accordance with policies established in accordance with law.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Oct. 14, 2023.
