2	To amend and reenact R.S. 56:324 and 325.5(B), relative to the commercial menhaden
3	fishery; to provide for menhaden fishing; to provide for reporting; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 56:324 and 325.5(B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	§324. Menhaden seines; restrictions
9	Anyone Any person legally taking menhaden shall not have in their
10	possession more than five percent, by weight, of any species of fish other than
11	menhaden and herring-like species.

13	§325.5 Commercial menhaden harvest reporting

15	B. Beginning February $\frac{10}{1}$, 2024, the department shall annually report to the
16	Senate Committee on Natural Resources and the House Committee on Natural
17	Resources and Environment the commercial menhaden harvest from the prior year

<u>Present law</u> provides that for anyone taking menhaden legally, the catch may have up to five percent by weight of other species of fish.

Proposed law changes "anyone" to "any person".

<u>Present law</u> requires that, beginning February 10, 2024, the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries must provide an annual menhaden harvest report for the prior year to the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the annual report start date <u>from</u> February 10, 2024, <u>to</u> February 1, 2024.

Effective August 1, 2023.
