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Abstract: Allows a person 16 years of age or older to be employed as a direct support professional, direct support worker, or personal care attendant for certain Medicaid-related services.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows any person, 16 years of age or older, to be employed as a direct support professional, direct support worker, or personal care attendant for Medicaid waiver services and Medicaid services.

<u>Proposed law</u> includes but is not limited to the following Medicaid waiver services and Medicaid services:

- (1) New Opportunities Waiver.
- (2) Residential Options Waiver.
- (3) Children's Choice Waiver.
- (4) Community Choices Waiver.
- (5) Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment program services.
- (6) Personal care services.
- (7) Long-term personal care services.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "direct support professional", "direct support worker", and "personal care attendant".
