Section 1. R.S. 14:69.1(A)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:		
§69.1. Illegal possession of stolen firearms

(2) It shall <u>not</u> be an affirmative defense to a prosecution for a violation of $\frac{1}{2}$

Abstract: Amends an affirmative defense to the crime of illegal possession of stolen firearms in regards to the offender's knowledge of the firearm's legality.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 14:69.1) provides for the crime of illegal possession of stolen firearms and provides for penalties.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 14:69.1(A)(2)) provides it shall be an affirmative defense to prosecution that the offender had no knowledge that the firearm was the subject of any form of misappropriation.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to provide that it shall no longer be an affirmative defense that the offender had no knowledge that the firearm was the subject of any form of misappropriation.

(Amends R.S. 14:69.1(A)(2))
