Abstract: Provides authorization for the use of monies in the Waste Tire Management Dedicated Fund Account for the purpose of the cleanup of abandoned waste tires.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides authorization for the use of monies in the Waste Tire Management Dedicated Fund Account for the purpose of the cleanup of abandoned waste tires if monies are available after all payments have been disbursed, in accordance with <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that monies from the account cannot be used for waste tire cleanup if the balance of the account is insufficient to meet the obligations owed to waste tire processors as provided for in <u>present law</u>.
