CAMPAIGN FINANCE. Provides for repayment of personal contributions or loans. (8/1/23) AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 18:1505.2(T), relative to campaign contributions; to provide for repayment of personal contributions or loans; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 18:1505.2(T) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §1505.2. Contributions; expenditures; certain prohibitions and limitations
T.(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsections $H$ and $I$ of this Section, any loans Loans a candidate makes to his own campaign, as provided for in this Section, may be repaid from any campaign funds contributions received in connection with an a subsequent election in which the eandidate qualiffed for a public office.
(2) The provisions of this Subsection shall apply only to those candidates who have terminated their public service as an elected official for at least one year from the date of their last day in office.

Proposed law provides that any loans made by a candidate to his own campaign may be repaid from any campaign contributions received in connection with a subsequent election.
