

## EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

## REVENUE EXPLANATION

This bill will decrease state general fund revenue by a negligible amount. The tax is collected as a purchase of stamps that have only been made by collectors. A few thousand dollars is collected each year and attributed to this tax. With this bill, the tax stamp will no longer be offered, which may increase collections in anticipation of its demise.
