17 (2) Every person with autism spectrum disorder or their court-appointed 18 guardian applying for a driver's license, an identification decal, or sticker shall 19 attach to the application a statement which contains proof verifying the applicant's 20 disability attested by one of the following: a medical physician, mental health 21 professional, or occupational therapist.

D. All documentation, and the information contained therein submitted
 pursuant to Subsection C of this Section shall be confidential and not subject to
 disclosure pursuant to the Public Records Law, R.S. 44:1 et seq. Any person seeking
 the documentation or the information contained therein must first obtain a court
 order after a hearing against the person or court-appointed guardian."
