BUILDING CODES: Provides relative to certain building code roofing inspections of a commercial or residential structure

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1730.23(J), relative to inspections of commercial and
3	residential structures; to provide for enforcement of building codes by municipalities
4	and parishes; to provide which individuals may conduct inspections on commercial
5	and residential structures; to provide criteria for roofing inspections; and to provide
6	for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

DIGEST

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Abstract: Creates exceptions for roofing inspections of any commercial and residential structure.

<u>Present law</u> requires that a properly registered certified building inspector conduct all inspections of any commercial or residential structure and requires that the inspector be present on site for such inspections.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> by requiring that inspections of any commercial or residential structure be done by a building code enforcement officer or a certified third-party provider.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that all building code enforcement officers or certified third-party providers be on site for inspections, except for roofing inspections.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows a building code enforcement officer or a certified third-party provider to accept photographs or videos that are location verified with geotagging for required roofing and reroofing inspections of any commercial or residential structure.
