A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend Louisiana State University student Cale Locicero on being named a recipient of a 2022-2023 National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the National Science Foundation's Graduate Research Fellowship Program is to ensure the quality, vitality, and diversity of the scientific and engineering workforce of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the program provides a five-year fellowship that includes financial support and an annual stipend of \$37,000 to students who demonstrate the greatest potential to contribute to the scientific competitiveness of the United States; and

WHEREAS, Cale Locicero is most deserving of the highest recognition for his incredible talent and for being named a recipient of a 2022-2023 National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship.
