### 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, after "To", delete "amend and reenact R.S. 32:410(B)(1)(a) and (b)(i)" and
insert "enact R.S. 32:410(G)"

5 On page 1, line 3, after "for" insert "interest in" and after "donation" delete "on" and insert 6 "during application or renewal of a"

8 On page 1, line 6, after "Section 1." delete "R.S. 32:410(B)(1)(a) and (b)(i) are hereby 9 amended and reenacted" and insert "R.S. 32:410(G) is hereby enacted"

11 On page 1, line 9, after "procedures," insert "*interest in bone marrow donation*,"

#### 12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 1, delete lines 12 through 17 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 11 and insert "G. 14 Any person between the ages of eighteen and forty years old applying for or renewing 15 their driver's license may indicate their intention to be a bone marrow donor on the application for the driver's license, or on any other document provided by the 16 department during the application or renewal process. The person shall give written 17 18 consent for their personal identifying information and contact information to be shared 19 with the national bone marrow donor program. The department shall provide the 20 personal identifying information and contact information of any person who has given written consent to share their information to the national bone marrow donor 21 22 program, for that program to contact the person to obtain their genetic information. The genetic information shall be stored in a secure national database accessible to 23 24 cancer doctors to find a match for their patients. The department shall promulgate 25 such rules as are necessary to implement this Paragraph."
