Present law provides that any loans made by a candidate to his own campaign may be repaid from campaign funds received in connection with an election in which the candidate qualified for a public office.

Proposed law provides that any loans made by a candidate to his own campaign may be repaid from any campaign contributions received.

Effective August 1, 2023.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to the original bill

1. Remove the requirement that campaign contributions used by a candidate to repay a loan to his own campaign be received in connection with a subsequent election.
