HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS OR INCREASE GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides relative to the Louisiana Community Health Worker Workforce Board

Proposed law creates the Louisiana Community Health Worker Workforce Board within the Louisiana Department of Health. Proposed law designates the 23 members that will be on the board.

Proposed law provides for powers, duties, and responsibilities of the board. Proposed law requires the board to do the following: 1) develop a program to enhance employer readiness in hiring community health workers; 2) development of core skills, roles, and competencies for community health workers in Louisiana; 3) develop standards and requirements for community health worker education and training programs; 4) develop a certification program for community health workers; 5) develop a certification program for community health workers; 6) review community health worker training programs; 7) recommend sustainable methods of financing community health worker services; and 8) track community health worker employment in Louisiana.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Additional cost to LDH will depend on the level of additional workload required of staff from the new board. Based on the functions and duties of the new board, specifically related to requirements to create a professional certification process, track community health worker employment (likely through a database), and developing standards for education and training programs for such workers, the department anticipates at least one additional program monitor position (\$90,000 salary and related benefits) and associated operational expenses (\$6,0000 in FY 24) initially to coordinate and manage the work generated from the board. In addition, members of the board (23) are anticipated to receive travel and lodging reimbursement for board meetings.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. The bill does not provide for professional services fees or a financing mechanism to fund the board, similar to other professional service boards.
