LEGISLATORS OR +\$3,411,407 GF EX See Note Provides for the compensation of members of the legislature

<u>Present law</u> provides that in addition to per diem and all other allowances, members of the legislature shall be paid an annual salary of \$16,800. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the annual salary for members of the legislature to \$60,000 for the term beginning in 2024.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the annual salary for the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of Representatives from \$32,000 to \$114,000 for the term beginning in 2024.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the annual salary for the president pro tempore of the Senate and the speaker pro tempore of the House of Representatives from \$24,500 to \$87,480 for the term beginning in 2024.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

This bill will increase expenditures of the legislature by \$3,411,407 in FY 24 associated with 6 months of salaries and benefits. This cost will be annualized for a total annual cost of \$6,822,814 in future fiscal years.

Beginning January 2024, the bill increases the annual salary of members of the legislature from \$16,800 to \$60,000, the annual salary of the president pro tempore and the speaker pro tempore from \$24,500 to \$87,480, and the annual salary of president and speaker from \$32,000 to \$114,000.

The total annual cost of the salary increase for members is \$6,048,000 (\$43,200 increase X 140 members).

The total annual cost of the salary increase for the pro tempores is \$125,960 (\$62,980 increase X 2 members).

The total annual cost of the salary increase for the president and speaker is \$164,000 (\$82,000 increase X 2 members).

The total annual cost of all the salary increases is \$6,337,960 (\$6,048,000+\$125,960+\$164,000)

The increase associated with related benefits is 484,854 (7.65% benefits x 6,337,960 salary).

Note: The bill provides for increase in salary every four years based on Consumer Price Index For All Urban Consumers (CPI-U). The first increase would occur in January 2028. The CPI-U for FY 28 is unknown at this time.

However, for illustrative purposes, had this law been in current effect and over the previous two terms, the percentage increase by term would have been as follows:

3 Term Average 10.39%

Assuming the CPI-U for the term beginning in 2028 were to equal the 3 term average from 2012 to 2020, the annual impact of a 10.39% increase is \$985,015 ((Current Base of \$2,653,573 + Growth of \$6,822,814) x 10.39%). Six months of this increase (\$492,507) is included in the FY 28 column of the expenditure table. Under this 10.39% assumed growth scenario, the adjustment to proposed base salaries beginning in 2024 would result in a salary of \$66,237 for members for the term starting in 2028, \$96,573 for the pro tempores and \$125,850 for the President and Speaker.

NOTE: Given the volatility of inflation, the percentage increase calculated from the CPI-U may vary significantly from the example given.
