Subject: Fiscal Intermediary Services Contracts

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Provides relative procurement of fiscal intermediary services

Current law allows for fiscal intermediary services contracts to be entered into through competitive sealed proposals or cooperative purchasing agreements. Proposed law removes fiscal intermediary services contracts from the statutory definition of a "multiyear contract". Removes the limitation that consulting services contracts ancillary to fiscal intermediary services contracts entered into through cooperative purchasing are capped at the lesser of twenty percent of the procurement amount or \$250,000. Requires fiscal intermediary contracts entered into through cooperative purchasing agreements be governed exclusively by the statutory provisions on cooperative purchasing, however they are subject to the approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget before execution.
