FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS. Provides for adding interest in bone marrow donorship to the list of options offered during application for renewal of a state-issued driver's license. (8/1/23)

2	To enact R.S. 32:410(G), relative to donation of bone marrow; to provide for interest in bone
3	marrow donation during application or renewal of a Louisiana state-issued driver's
4	license; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 32:410(G) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§410. Form of license; photograph, signature of licensee, anatomical gift statement,
8	declaration of life-sustaining procedures, interest in bone marrow
9	donation, and additional information on license
10	* * *
11	<b>G. Any person between the ages of eighteen and forty years old applying</b>
12	for or renewing their driver's license may indicate their intention to be a bone
13	marrow donor on the application for the driver's license, or on any other
14	document provided by the department during the application or renewal
15	process. The person shall give written consent for their personal identifying
16	information and contact information to be shared with the National Marrow
17	Donor Program. The department shall provide the personal identifying

1	information and contact information of any person who has given written
2	consent to share their information to the National Marrow Donor Program, for
3	that program to contact the person to obtain their genetic information. The
4	genetic information shall be stored in a secure national database accessible to
5	cancer doctors to find a match for their patients. The department shall
6	promulgate such rules as are necessary to implement this Paragraph.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for any person 18 to 40 to give written consent and indicate their intention to donate bone marrow on their driver's license application. <u>Proposed law</u> further indicates applicants that give consent will allow their genetic information to be obtained and stored in a national database and accessible by cancer doctors.
