Peacock

<u>Present law</u> provides that any loans made by a candidate to his own campaign may be repaid from campaign funds received in connection with an election in which the candidate qualified for a public office.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that notwithstanding any other provision of law any loans made by a candidate to his own campaign may be repaid from any campaign contributions received.

Effective August 1, 2023.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental</u> Affairs to the original bill

1. Remove the requirement that campaign contributions used by a candidate to repay a loan to his own campaign be received in connection with a subsequent election.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Clarify that the proposed law applies notwithstanding any other legal provisions.
