| 9  | married for twenty-nine years until his death; and   |
| 10 | WHEREAS, Angelina and Dalton worked in the fields to provide for their ten                   |
| 11 | children: Evelyn Narcisse, Alvin Narcisse, Peter Narcisse, Paul Narcisse, Angelina           |
| 12 | Narcisse-Morgan, Christopher Narcisse, Belva Narcisse-Marsh, Mildred Narcisse-Pratt, the     |
| 13 | late Calvin Narcisse, and Leo Narcisse; and  |
| 14 | WHEREAS, in 1954, Angelina became employed in the cafeteria at the University                |
| 15 | of Louisiana at Lafayette, where she fed the stomachs and hearts of hundreds of students for |
