PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS. Creates the Louisiana Port Authority Advisory Commission. (8/1/23)

AN ACT

2	To enact Chapter 53 of Title 34 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised
3	of R.S. 34:5210 through 5215, relative to the creation of the Louisiana Port Authority
4	Advisory Commission; to provide for definitions; to establish a board of directors;
5	to specify the purpose, powers, jurisdiction, and duties of the commission; to provide
6	relative to the ethics code and public records; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. Chapter 53 of Title 34 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
9	comprised of R.S. 34:5210 through 5215, is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	CHAPTER 53. LOUISIANA PORT AUTHORITY
11	ADVISORY COMMISSION
12	§5210. Short title
13	This Chapter shall be known and may be referred to as the "Louisiana
14	Port Authority Advisory Act".
15	§5211. Definitions
16	The following definitions shall apply:
17	(1) "Act" shall mean the Louisiana Port Authority Advisory Act.

1	(2) "Commission" shall mean the Louisiana Port Authority Advisory
2	Commission created by this Chapter.
3	(3) "Board" shall mean the directors of the commission.
4	(4) "Department" shall mean the Louisiana Department of
5	Transportation and Development.
6	(5) "Secretary" shall mean the secretary of the Louisiana Department
7	of Transportation and Development.
8	§5212. Purpose; legislative findings
9	A. The legislature hereby finds and declares it necessary to provide a
10	forum for the exchange of information between the legislature, the department,
11	and commission members representing the maritime port industry located in
12	the parishes of East Baton Rouge, Jefferson, Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard,
13	St. Charles, St. James, St. John, St. Tammany, and West Baton Rouge.
14	B. The legislature hereby finds and declares that it is a matter of public
15	necessity to create the Louisiana Port Authority Advisory Commission to
16	provide the legislature and the department a broad perspective regarding
17	maritime ports and transportation-related matters to be considered in
18	formulating department policies concerning the Louisiana maritime port system
19	located along and near the lower Mississippi River.
20	<u>§5213. Duties</u>
21	The commission shall be responsible for the following:
22	A. Prepare a comprehensive one-year, five-year, and ten-year maritime
23	port mission plan and submit the plan to the governor, speaker of the House of
24	Representatives, president of the Senate, senate and house committees on
25	transportation, highways and public works, and the senate and house
26	committees on commerce, no later than December first of each year.
27	B. Review each project eligible to be funded pursuant to R.S. 34:3451 et
28	seq. and make recommendations for approval or disapproval to the legislature.
29	C. Advise the legislature and the department on matters relating to port

2	§5214. Louisiana Port Authority Advisory Commission; creation; board of
3	commissioners; compensation
4	A. The Louisiana Port Authority Advisory Commission is created to
5	assess and make recommendations relative to ports located along the lower
6	Mississippi River in the state of Louisiana.
7	B. The domicile of the commission shall be East Baton Rouge Parish.
8	C. There shall be seven commissioners on the board who shall be the
9	governing body and shall be composed as follows:
10	(1) The president of the board of commissioners for the Port of New
11	Orleans or his designee.
12	(2) The president of the board of commissioners for the Port of South
13	Louisiana or his designee.
14	(3) The president of the board of commissioners for the Port of Greater
15	Baton Rouge or his designee.
16	(4) The president of the board of commissioners for Plaquemines Port
17	Harbor and Terminal District or his designee.
18	(5) The president of the board of commissioners for the Port of St.
19	Bernard Port, Harbor and Terminal District or his designee.
20	(6) The secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development
21	or his designee.
22	(7) The secretary of Louisiana Economic Development or his designee.
23	D. Commissioners shall serve as long as they hold their current position
24	as president of their respective port or secretary of their respective agency. The
25	commission shall elect from its members a chairman, a vice chairman, and a
26	secretary-treasurer who shall serve two-year terms.
27	E. Commissioners shall not be entitled to any salary for the performance
28	of their duties, but each may be reimbursed by their represented entity for
29	actual expenses incurred in the performance of all duties in connection with

business of the commission. Commissioners may be reimbursed for mileage

2 expenses incurred for attendance at meetings of the commission. The mileage 3 allowance shall be fixed by the commission in an amount not to exceed the mileage allowance authorized under state travel regulations, at rates and 4 standards as promulgated by the division of administration subject to the 5 availability of funds. 6 7 §5215. Meetings; quorum 8 The commission shall meet at least biannually and may meet more 9 frequently upon call of the chairman. A majority of the commissioners shall 10 constitute a quorum for the transaction of official business. All official actions 11 of the commission shall require an affirmative vote of the commissioners 12 present and voting at any meeting.

Proposed law creates the Louisiana Port Authority Advisory Commission.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the purpose of the commission and identifies the ports the commission represents which are located along and near the lower Mississippi River.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for duties and responsibilities of the commission including preparing a maritime port mission plan, developing a one-, five-, and ten-year plan, reviewing each project eligible to be funded under the port construction and development priority program and making recommendations to the legislature.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the composition of board of commissioners, compensation of the commission, meetings, and quorum requirements.
