Abstract: Changes the requirements needed for cosmetology licensure.

Present law requires a course of practical training and technical instruction extending over a period of not less than nine months and including not less than 1500 hours for a cosmetology license.

Proposed law changes present law by reducing the hours required for a course to not less than seven months and 15 days consecutively and not less than 1200 hours of practical training and technical instruction for cosmetology licensure.

Effective Aug. 1, 2024.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Commerce to the original bill:

1. Add an effective date of Aug. 1, 2024.
2. Make technical changes.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Remove proposed law that requires the board to create and maintain a website relative to cosmetology licensure.
2. Make technical changes.
