 Creates the Louisiana Cybersecurity Commission. (8/1/23)

Proposed law enacts the LA Cybersecurity Commission within the Division of Administration to coordinate cybersecurity efforts among local, state, tribal, and federal governments and the private sector. Under proposed law, the Cybersecurity Commission shall have 21 members that serve for four years - 11 governmental members and ten (10) members appointed by the governor. Proposed law provides for the powers and duties of the commission. Proposed law requires the Office of Technology Services within the Division of Administration to provide staffing to the commission. Proposed law requires the commission to provide an annual report to the Office of the Governor, the Joint Legislative Committee on Technology and Cybersecurity, and the House and Senate select committees on Homeland Security.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. In December 2017, Executive Order JBE 17-31 created the LA Cybersecurity Commission that coordinates cybersecurity efforts among state governmental agencies, local governments, tribal governments, private companies, and academic institutions. The proposed law codifies this executive order into the LA Revised Statutes. This fiscal note presumes that the Division of Administration will continue to provide administrative support to the council; however, these costs are expected to be minimal and absorbed within their existing operating budget.
