2 Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 49:112, the sum of \$12,500,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the State General Fund (Direct) 4 for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 to be allocated to pay consent judgments and other final 5 judgments against the state, Board of Tax Appeals judgments and recommendations for 6 payment of a claim against the state, and reimbursements of attorney fees, all as provided 7 in this Section. A judgment or recommendation may only be paid from this appropriation 8 if it is final. All judgments and recommendations provided for in this Section shall be paid 9 as to principal, interest, court costs, and expert witness fees as awarded in each judgment or 10 recommendation, it being the intent herein that when the provisions of a judgment or 11 recommendation conflict with the provisions of this Act, the provisions of the judgment or 12 recommendation shall be controlling. Any other provision of this Act not in conflict with 13 the provisions of a judgment or recommendation shall control. Payment shall be made as 14 to each judgement, Board of Tax Appeals judgment or recommendation, or reimbursement 15 for attorney fees only after presentation to the state treasurer of documentation required by 16 the state treasurer. Further, all judgments and recommendations provided for in this Section 17 shall be deemed to have been paid on the effective date of the Act, and interest shall cease 18 to run as of that date.
