10 On page 2, between lines 23 and 24, insert the following:

# 11 "§31.7.1. Waiver of salary or compensation

- A.(1) A member or member-elect of the legislature may waive all or any portion of the salary or other compensation for his service in the legislature. Any member or member-elect who chooses to waive all or any portion of the salary or other compensation for his service in the legislature shall submit to the payroll officer of his house of the legislature an affidavit containing his name, the date, and a statement of the fact that he is waiving all or a portion of his salary or compensation at least fourteen days prior to the commencement of the next pay period.
- (2) Upon receipt of the affidavit as provided in this Subsection, the payroll officer shall ensure that the member of legislature is paid or compensated at the salary or compensation indicated in the affidavit beginning at the commencement of the next pay period.
- B.(1) If the member of legislature decides to change the amount of the salary or compensation he receives after having waived all or any portion thereof, the member of legislature shall, at least fourteen days prior to the commencement of the next pay period, submit to the payroll officer of his house of the legislature an affidavit containing his name, the date, and a statement of fact that he is revoking his previous affidavit and the amount of the salary or compensation he chooses to receive.
- (2) Upon receipt of the affidavit as provided in this Subsection, the payroll officer shall ensure that the member of legislature is paid or compensated at the salary or compensation indicated in the affidavit beginning at the commencement of the next pay period.
