Abstract: Requires free school breakfast and lunch for certain public school students.

Present law provides for the provision of school meals. Proposed law:

- (1) Provides that students who qualify for reduced-price meals shall be provided a free breakfast and lunch.
- (2) Provides that for each breakfast or lunch served free of charge in accordance with proposed law, the state Dept. of Education shall reimburse the governing authority of a nutrition program provider for the meal an amount equal to the difference between the reimbursement rates provided by the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture for a free meal and a reduced-price meal.
- (3) Provides that proposed law shall be implemented beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill:

1. Limit applicability of proposed law to students who qualify for reduced-price school meals.
2. Require reimbursement by the state Dept. of Education.
