RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS: Provides relative to the board of trustees of the Firefighters' Retirement System

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2260(A)(2) and (6), relative to the Firefighters' Retirement  
3 System; to provide for membership on the system's board of trustees; and to provide  
4 for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published  
6 as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution  
7 of Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 11:2260(A)(2) and (6) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as  
10 follows:

11 §2260. Administration

12 A. Board of trustees:

14 (2)(a) The board shall consist of ~~ten~~ twelve trustees as follows:

15 ~~(a)~~ (i) Two members of the Professional Fire Fighters Association, who ~~shall~~  
16 ~~be~~ are members of the system, and who shall be elected by a majority of the officers  
17 of the association, ~~as follows:~~

18 ~~(i) One member shall be elected in December, 1988, to take office January~~  
19 ~~1, 1989, to serve until January 1, 1992, and his successor shall be elected for a term~~  
20 ~~of five years, commencing on January 1, 1992.~~



1 "affirmative vote" shall mean that the vote shall be cast in favor of approving any  
2 motion.

3 \* \* \*

4 Section 2.(A) Notwithstanding any contrary provision of R.S. 11:2260(A)(2) in  
5 effect on June 30, 2023, any member of the Firefighters' Retirement System board of trustees  
6 who is serving on June 30, 2023, may complete his term.

7 (B) Elections for additional members of the Firefighters' Retirement System board  
8 of trustees pursuant to R.S. 11:2260(A)(2)(a)(ii) and (v) as provided by this Act shall be  
9 conducted by October 1, 2023. The terms of trustees elected in such elections begin on  
10 September 1, 2024.

11 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
12 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
13 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
15 effective on the day following such approval.

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HB 44 Engrossed 2023 Regular Session Horton

**Abstract:** Provides for membership on the board of trustees of the Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS).

Present law provides that FRS is governed by a board of trustees comprised of 10 members. Proposed law increases the number of trustees to 12.

Present law provides that one trustee is a fire chief elected by the fire chiefs. Proposed law provides for two such trustees.

Present law provides that one trustee is a system retiree selected by the board from nominations submitted by system retirees. Proposed law provides for two retirees to be elected by retired members and beneficiaries of the system.

Proposed law retains present law regarding the remaining members:

- (1) Two trustees are members of the Professional Fire Fighters Assoc. selected by the association's officers.

- (2) Two mayors appointed by the La. Municipal Assoc.
- (3) A member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the speaker, or the member's designee and the chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement, or his designee.
- (4) The state treasurer or his designee.
- (5) The commissioner of administration or his designee.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Retirement to the original bill:

1. Remove proposed law that provides for:
  - (a) Five retired firefighters elected to the board from geographic districts.
  - (b) An active firefighter elected to the board by active members.
  - (c) A surviving spouse elected to the board by the retirees and spouses of deceased members.
  - (d) Removal of current members of the board.
