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| HB 459 Reengrossed | 2023 Regular Session | Travis Johnson |
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Abstract: Adds that a phlebotomist working for certain testing locations and laboratories is exempt from certification requirements.

<u>Present law</u> exempts a phlebotomist or an individual acting as a phlebotomist from certification requirements if he is employed by a licensed physician, clinic, hospital, nursing home, or licensed healthcare facility.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds testing locations, or laboratories licensed or certified under the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 to the list of facilities where a phlebotomist is not required to be certified.

(Amends R.S. 37:1313(D) and 1318(A); Repeals R.S. 37:1315(A)(1))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Remove <u>proposed law</u> that would allow a phlebotomist to practice without a certification in certain circumstances.
- 2. Add that a phlebotomist is exempt from certification requirements if the phlebotomist works for a testing location or laboratory licensed or certified under the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988.
- 3. Make technical corrections.
