**Abstract:** Authorizes the city of New Orleans to charge an additional fee for alcoholic beverage permits.

Present law authorizes parishes and municipalities to charge permit fees not to exceed \$500 for beverages of high alcoholic content.

Proposed law retains present law and authorizes the city of New Orleans to exceed the \$500 maximum for Class A, Class B, and Class C dealers.

Present law authorizes parishes and municipalities with a population of 400,000 or more to charge permit fees not to exceed \$135 for wholesale and Class A retail dealers of beverages of low alcoholic content.

Proposed law retains present law and authorizes the city of New Orleans to charge an additional \$250 for Class A, Class B, and Class C dealers.
