GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION

RE NO IMPACT See Note

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Establishes a chief resilience officer and provides for interagency coordination of resilience planning

Proposed law creates the Chief Resilience Officer (CRO) in statute as a position within the Office of the Governor to build long-term economic, environmental, health, and opportunity resilience for Louisiana residents. The position is appointed by the governor, and confirmed by the Senate. Duties of the CRO include coordinating the newly created Interagency Resilience Coordination Team and the Louisiana Resilience Task Force. Provides for the membership of the Resilience Coordination Team and the Resilience Task Force. Provides for the development and submission of an annual statewide resilience report.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation provides for the appointment of a Chief Resilience Officer (CRO) to oversee resiliency initiatives in the state. Executive Order JBE 2020-19, created a CRO position in the Governor’s Office and an existing employee is currently serving in the role, resulting in no immediate additional costs. Proposed legislation authorizes the governor to assign other personnel to assist the CRO as deemed necessary.
