2 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 13 in their entirety and insert the following:

"Section 28. A. The family is essential to a free society. The relationship between parent and child is preeminent in establishing and maintaining the wellbeing of the child. Parents have the responsibility for providing the basic necessities of life as well as love and affection to their children. Parents have the paramount right to raise their children in accordance with their own values and traditions. Parents shall make the decisions regarding where and with whom the child shall reside, the educational, moral, ethical, and religious training of the child, the medical, psychiatric, surgical, and preventive health care of the child, and the discipline of the child. Children owe to their parents respect, obedience, and affection.

14B. The role of the state in the family is limited and should only be asserted15when there is a serious threat to the family, the parents, or the child. Extraordinary16procedures established by law are meant to be used only when required by necessity,17and then with due respect for the right of the parents, the children, and the institution18of the family, and only to the extent that such procedures are not prohibited by this19Constitution. Any law, rule, regulation, or decision which would diminish parental20rights as provided in Paragraph (A) of this Section shall be subject to strict scrutiny."

"Do you support an amendment to provide that parents have the fundamental right
to raise their children in accordance with their own values and traditions and make
decisions regarding the well-being of the child? (Adds Article 1, Section 28)"
