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HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 131

CRIME: Creates a commission to study the crime of communicating false information of a planned bombing on school property, at a school-sponsored function, or in a firearm-free zone when the offender is a juvenile

A RESOLUTION

2	To create a commission to study the crime of communicating false information of a planned
3	bombing on school property, at a school-sponsored function, or in a firearm-free
4	zone when the offender is a juvenile and to report its findings to the House
5	Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice and the House Committee on
6	Education prior to the convening of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature of
7	Louisiana.
8	WHEREAS, the Louisiana House of Representatives recognizes and acknowledges
9	that school safety is of the highest importance; and
10	WHEREAS, R.S. 17:416.16 provides relative to school crisis management and
11	response plans, including requirements relative to their preparation, content, review,
12	revision, and rehearsal; and
13	WHEREAS, R.S. 14:54.6 provides for the crime of communicating false information
14	of planned bombing on school property, at a school-sponsored function, or in a firearm-free
15	zone; and
16	WHEREAS, the advent of social media can facilitate the communication of a bomb
17	threat from any individual, regardless of age, in any location, and at any time; and
18	WHEREAS, the communication of a bomb threat, regardless of its veracity, creates
19	panic among students, faculty, and their family members; and

1	WHEREAS, the communication of a bomb threat creates a strain on emergency
2	services and law enforcement personnel at the local, parish, and state levels due to the
3	seriousness of the claim and the rapid response time needed; and
4	WHEREAS, an assessment of how often fake bomb threats are communicated to
5	schools within this state can provide for even greater protection of students, faculty, first
6	responders, law enforcement, and the community as a whole.
7	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
8	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby create a commission to study the crime of
9	communicating false information of a planned bombing on school property, at a
10	school-sponsored function, or in a firearm-free zone when the offender is a juvenile and to
11	report its findings to the House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice and the
12	House Committee on Education prior to the convening of the 2024 Regular Session of the
13	Legislature of Louisiana.
14	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study commission shall be composed of the
15	following members:
16	(1) The state superintendent of education, or his designee.
17	(2) The executive director of the Louisiana District Attorneys Association, or his
18	designee.
19	(3) The executive director of the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association, or his designee.
20	(4) The deputy director of the Office of Juvenile Justice, or his designee.
21	(5) The mayor-president of Lafayette Parish, or his designee.
22	(6) The adjutant general of the Louisiana Army National Guard, or his designee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association shall provide staff support to the commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to each
 of the commission members provided in this Resolution.
