1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, between "property; and "and to" insert "to require adoption of  
3 administrative rules; to require annual reports;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the beginning of line 12, change "(11)" to "(11)(a)"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 14, between "and" and "assets" insert "other"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, delete lines 15 and 16 and insert the following:

11 (b) No advertising or sponsorship signs may be placed pursuant to this  
12 Paragraph until the secretary promulgates rules and regulations, in accordance with  
13 the Administrative Procedure Act, that include, at a minimum, all of the following:

14 (i) Specifications regarding types of businesses with which sponsorship  
15 agreements are authorized and with which sponsorship agreements are prohibited.

16 (ii) Specifications regarding the size, types, and placement of advertisements  
17 and sponsorship signs that will be allowed on or within agency property.

18 (c) The Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism shall submit a report  
19 by February first each year to the House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and  
20 Cultural Affairs, the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and  
21 International Affairs, and the legislature in accordance with R.S. 24:772  
22 summarizing each sponsorship agreement that is in effect at the time of the report."
