1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 8, after "1112," delete the remainder of the line and delete line 9 in its
3 entirety and insert "and R.S."

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 18, after "agreements;" delete the remainder of the line and insert "to provide
6 for an effective date;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, line 18, after "president," and before "jury" change "policy" to "police"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 4, line 3, after "president," and before "jury" change "policy" to "police"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 14, line 4, after "president," and before "jury" change "policy" to "police"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 14, delete lines 6 through 28 in their entirety and on page 15, delete lines 1 through
15 3 in their entirety

16 AMENDMENT NO. 7

17 On page 15, at the beginning of line 4, change "Section 3." to "Section 2."

18 AMENDMENT NO. 8

19 On page 15, at the beginning of line 12, change "Section 4." to "Section 3."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 9

21 On page 15, delete lines 16 through 24 in their entirety and insert the following:

22 "Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
23 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
24 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
25 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
26 effective on the day following such approval."
