



1           WHEREAS, multiple homes, along with vehicles parked at these residences, have  
2 been struck and severely damaged as a result of cars crashing onto these properties; and

3           WHEREAS, the crosswalk cannot be removed without legislative action as well as  
4 an alternate safety installation for crossing LA 1; and

5           WHEREAS, it is urgent to assess the needs of residents and citizens who travel  
6 through the 4600 block of North Market Street to protect drivers and the community from  
7 further harm; and

8           WHEREAS, the community around the 4600 block of North Market Street  
9 desperately needs the Department of Transportation and Development to evaluate and  
10 implement whichever measures are necessary to resolve the current roadway issues to ensure  
11 safety throughout the community.

12           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
13 urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to reevaluate the  
14 location of a crosswalk in the 4600 block of North Market Street, United States Highway 71,  
15 in Shreveport, Louisiana, and to construct an appropriate installation in this area to ensure  
16 the safety of pedestrians, prevent property damage, and avert future deadly automobile  
17 accidents.

18           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
19 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
