- 16 "§2133. Authority; further powers and duties

17 The authority shall have the powers necessary and convenient to implement and 18 effectuate the purposes and provisions of this Part and the purposes of the authority and the 19 powers delegated by other laws, including but not limited to the power to:

(1) Sue and be sued; have perpetual succession; make, execute and deliver contracts,
 conveyances, and other instruments necessary and convenient to the exercise of its powers;
 and to make and amend its bylaws by a majority vote of the board.

(2) Solicit and accept gifts, grants, donations, loans, and other assistance from any
 person or entity, private or public, or the federal, state, or local governments or any agency
 thereof, such gifts, grants, donations, loans, and other assistance to be immediately deposited
 upon receipt into the account provided for in R.S. 22:2134(A).

(3) (2) Establish programs in conjunction with other state agencies, local governing
 authorities, and law enforcement agencies for motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud
 prevention, detection and enforcement, which shall include the Attorney General's Criminal
 Division and Investigation Division.

31 (4) (3) Make grants to other state agencies, local governing authorities, and law
 32 enforcement agencies for motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud prevention, detection and
 33 enforcement.

36 (6) (5) Deposit all monies received for the purposes of this Part into the Automobile
 37 Theft and Insurance Fraud Prevention Authority Dedicated Fund, Account provided for in
 38 R.S. 22:2134.

39 (7) (6) Contract for goods and services and engage personnel as is necessary,
 40 including the services of private consultants, auditors, and others for rendering professional
 41 services, as provided by law, payable out of any money of the account legally available for
 42 such purpose. Additionally, the board may authorize the attorney general to contract for the

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- 1 services of ad hoc prosecutors or other legal assistance, payable out of any money of the 2 account legally available for such purpose. 3 (8) Indemnify and procure insurance indemnifying the members of the board from 4 personal loss from liability resulting from an action or inaction of the board. 5 (9) Do all other things necessary and convenient to achieve the objectives and purposes of the authority of this Part. 6 7 §2134. Automobile Theft and Insurance Fraud Prevention Authority Dedicated Fund 8 Account 9 10 B. Any monies in the account shall be administered only by the director of the 11 authority commissioner, upon a majority vote of the board, in the following order of priority: 12 13 (3) To achieve the purposes and objectives of this Part, which may include but not 14 be limited to the following: 15 (a) Providing financial support to state or local law enforcement agencies and 16 prosecutors, including but not limited to the office of attorney general, for motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud prevention, detection and enforcement. 17 18 (b) Providing financial support to state or local law enforcement agencies and 19 prosecutors, including but not limited to the office of attorney general, for programs 20 designed to reduce the incidence of motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud. 21 (c) Providing financial support to state and local prosecutors, including but not 22 limited to the office of attorney general, for programs designed to reduce the incidence of 23 motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud. 24 (d) Conducting educational and public awareness programs designed to inform the 25 citizens of the state about methods of preventing motor vehicle theft and combating insurance fraud. 26 27 28 §2135. Plan of operation 29 A. The authority shall develop and implement a plan of operation upon the 30 recommendations of the director commissioner. B.(1) The plan of operation shall include an assessment of the scope of the problem 31 32 of motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud, including a determination of particular areas of 33 the state where the problem is most severe, an analysis of various methods of combating the 34 problem of motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud, a plan for providing financial support 35 for efforts to combat motor vehicle theft and insurance fraud, and an estimate of funds 36 required to implement the plan.
- 37 (2) The plan of operation shall not include any independent investigative or
  38 enforcement activities.
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
