1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 3, delete lines 20 through 25 and insert the following:
- 3 "A. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 40:1730.21 et seq. and R.S. 40:1730.51et seq.
- 4 to the contrary, a licensed dealer or developer shall be allowed to use a manufactured and
- 5 modular home model to conduct only manufactured and modular home sales-related activity
- 6 <u>at the location of sales of manufactured and modular homes. Manufactured and modular</u>
- 7 <u>home sales-related activity includes but is not limited to executing contracts, making copies</u>
- 8 or phone calls, showing manufactured and modular home models, or engaging in any other
- 9 <u>sales-related activity.</u>
- 10 B. The licensed dealer or developer shall also adhere to the following requirements:
- 11 (1) There shall be no overnight sleeping in the manufactured or modular home.
- 12 (2) The manufactured or modular home shall be properly installed in accordance with
- applicable federal and state statutes, rules, regulations, and codes."
