1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 17, and insert the following:

"Section 2. The levy of a new tax, an increase in an existing tax, or a repeal
of an existing tax exemption increase of a tax rate or the enactment of a new tax, a
tax exemption, exclusion, deduction, credit, or rebate shall require the enactment of
a law by two-thirds of the elected members of each house of the legislature. The
enactment of any other law relative to taxes shall require the favorable vote of at
least a majority of the elected members of each house of the legislature."

10 On page 2, delete lines 5 through 10 and insert the following:

11	"Do you support an amendment to require the enactment of a law by at least
12	two-thirds of the elected members of each house of the legislature to enact
13	increases in tax rates, new taxes, or tax exemptions, exclusions, deductions,
14	credits, or rebates and to allow the enactment of any other law relative to
15	taxes by a favorable vote of a majority of the elected members of each house
16	of the legislature, including repealing or reducing a tax, tax exemption,
17	exclusion, deduction, credit, or rebate?"
