Abstract: Authorizes an increase in transcription fees in civil and criminal cases.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in civil cases a court reporter shall be paid \$1.50 per page for the original testimony reported and transcribed and 35¢ per page for copies.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that in civil and criminal cases a court reporter shall not be paid an amount less than three dollars nor more than six dollars, as determined by a majority of judges, for each 32-line page of transcribed testimony and no less than one dollar per copy.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the increase in court costs or fees shall become effective upon approval by the Judicial Council.
