

1 WHEREAS, elected officials want to work with the armed forces, law enforcement,
2 and advocates to develop a plan to improve military eligibility which includes nonviolent
3 offenders between the ages of eighteen and twenty-five with a high school diploma or
4 college degree, such as an associate degree or bachelor's degree, to participate in the pilot
5 program and join the United States Army.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
7 memorialize the United States Congress to take such actions as are necessary to assist in the
8 establishment of a Louisiana pilot program for the recruitment of new United States Army
9 members to address the military recruitment shortage.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
11 presiding officers of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Congress of the
12 United States of America and to each member of the Louisiana congressional delegation.
