

1 WHEREAS, because of its large number of parks and facilities and the vast array of
2 activities and programs the NORD Commission offers, it is imperative that the commission
3 be prepared to address all kinds of medical emergencies; and

4 WHEREAS, currently, the NORD Commission is not required to have and maintain
5 AEDs on its premises; and

6 WHEREAS, it is the duty of Louisiana legislators to ensure that residents of the state
7 have sufficient access to efficient, life-saving medical equipment in as many ways as
8 possible.

9 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
10 urge and request the New Orleans Recreation Development Commission to acquire and
11 maintain automated external defibrillators on its premises for medical emergencies.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
13 chief executive officer of the New Orleans Recreation Development Commission.
