

1 Title Law is not without consequence. For example, the purchaser's failure to obtain
2 a certificate of title to the vehicle in accordance with the Vehicle Certificate of Title
3 Law prevents the purchaser from acquiring a "marketable title." R.S. 32:706. In
4 addition, a person's knowing failure to comply with disclosure provisions of the
5 Vehicle Certificate of Title Law may expose that person to criminal and/or civil
6 liability. See, e.g., R.S. 32:706.1. Notwithstanding those and other obligations
7 imposed by the Vehicle Certificate of Title Law upon parties involved in the transfer
8 of vehicles, the provisions of this Chapter govern the transfer of ownership of such
9 vehicles."
